### **RE-ENROLLMENT DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 11, 2022**

To re-enroll go to olgcs.org, click on the "Registration or Re-Enrollment!" box and proceed as directed. A non-refundable deposit of \$50 will be processed through FACTS Management within two business days of re-enrollment. 2021-22 tuition/fees must be current in order to re-enroll for 2022-23.

### ALL RE-ENROLLING EDCHOICE SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS:

- (1) Complete the attached 2022-2023 Renewal Form(see below) and attach a recent Electric, Gas, Water, Sewer, Cable/Internet bill. Other Acceptable Documents: Monthly mortgage statement and signed Lease/rental agreement and one (1) other official document with parent's name and address.
- (2) Complete the attached 2022-23 Income Verification Form (see below), and attach either 4 current pay stubs for each job, or your W-2 forms, or your 2021 Federal Income Tax Return forms. Families applying for the Expansion scholarship MUST have their income verified by EdChoice; it is NOT optional. Traditional Scholarship families who qualify under the State's income guidelines will not need to pay the difference between the Traditional EdChoice Scholarship and tuition. Parents/Guardians may now create an OH/ID account and use the EdChoice Income Verification System to enter and submit their income information at <a href="https://safe.ode.state.oh.us/portal">https://safe.ode.state.oh.us/portal</a>. You may apply for the needs-based CEF Scholarship at <a href="https://safe.ode.state.oh.us/portal">www.catholicbestchoice.org</a> to cover this difference.
- (3) Parents must complete the attached 2022-2023 Request Form for newly enrolled siblings of current students.

NOTE: The State will not process incomplete forms or forms without the required documents.
