Saint Athanasia of Aegina

Saint Athanasia of Aegina was a greek widow and abbess who lived on an Aegean Island. She was the daughter of Christian nobles, Niketes and Irene. Athanasia experienced a mystical union of a star merging with her heart while weaving at the loom when she was a young girl. She wanted a spiritual life, but an imperial edict required all single women of marriageable age to marry soldiers. At her parents' urging she complied and married a young soldier. Athanasia's husband of two weeks was killed fighting Saracens. She remarried, and her second husband, a deeply religious man, decided to become a monk. Athanasia agreed and converted her home into a convent, where she became an abbess. She was known for her miraculous healing of the sick and those seen as possessed. Moving the convent to Timia, Athanasia became an advisor to the Byzantine empress during her seven-year stay in onstantinople. She died of natural causes in Timia in 860.

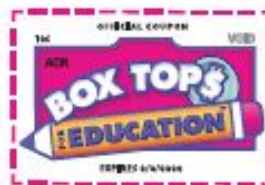
