Saint Fara

Burgundofara (Fara) was the daughter of Count Agneric, courtier of King Theodebert II. She refused her father's demands that she marry, and became Abbess of a convent she convinced him to build, and ruled for thirty-seven years. Named Evoriacum, the convent was renamed for her after her death, and in time became the famous Benedictine Abbey of Faremoutiers. She is also known as Fare. Her feast day is April 3rd.

Modified Grading Procedure for Online Learning (Grades 4-8) Updated 4/3/20

As we continue to navigate our new distance learning platform, we have decided to adjust how students' work is recorded in Option C. This modification will better enable students and parents to track assignments which still need to be completed and submitted to teachers.

Students need to continue to work on completing all work which is assigned in Google Classroom. The grade of COMPLETE (C) will be given to all students who achieve a satisfactory score on individual assignments and assessments. The grade of INCOMPLETE (I) will be given to all students who DO NOT achieve a satisfactory score on individual assignments and assessments. Any student who earns an INCOMPLETE will need to redo the assignment until they earn a satisfactory score.

Please note: To locate any assignments not yet turned in, the student will need to click on "Missing" under the "ASSIGNMENTS" heading on his/her Option C Dashboard. Students may still complete and submit these assignments as soon as possible.

Students should continue to reach out to teachers via email if they receive an INCOMPLETE (I) to see how they can improve on the assignment.



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
