## Notes from the School Office

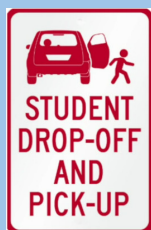
\*If your student is going to be absent or tardy, please call the office at 513-931-3070 ext. 4 BEFORE 8:00am to report this.

\*ALL visitors during school hours will need an appointment to enter the school building. To make an appointment, please email the person you would like to meet with (administration, teacher, etc.). If you come to the front door without an appointment, you will be asked to wait outside while you are being helped.

\*Afternoon transportation changes need to be communicated with the student before they come to school. If there is an emergency, please call the office, but changes cannot be made every day.

\*If your student forgets their lunch, they should buy lunch in the cafeteria. If it is an emergency, you can drop the lunch off in the office, but this should not happen every day.

### IMMUNIZATIONS Needed-New Students and 7th Graders

Please remember to send in a current copy of your child's immunizations to the school. This applies to your child if they are new to OLG this year or in 7<sup>th</sup> grade. The 7<sup>th</sup> grade students need to have the tdap and meningococcal vaccines for entry into 7<sup>th</sup> grade. These are requirements for the first day of school in the state of Ohio. We have given families a 2 week grace period from the start of school to get these records into school or your child will not be permitted to attend school starting on September 12<sup>th</sup>.

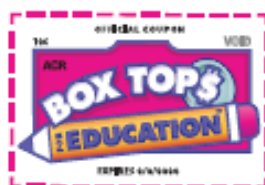
