Campus Ministry Corner

One of the many ways we grow in faith as a school community is by attending All-school Mass each Tuesday. Mass is the most important prayer of the Catholic Church. Students in grades 1-5 prepared this week for Mass by visiting Church, practicing responses and movements, and learning about the Catholic belief in Christ's Real Presence in the Eucharist. We reviewed how to receive Communion for all our students who are Catholic and have received First Communion. We shared that all our words and actions in Church, and especially at Mass, are a way to show reverence, honor, and love for God.

We invite you to support your student in this prayer at home. A great way is to ask about what they learned or did at Mass practice this week. You could also share what reverence looks like and means to you. Finally, take a moment each Tuesday to ask about your child's experience at Mass.

Families are welcome to join us for Mass at 8:25 on Tuesdays. Please enter through the church main doors. Families and parishioners sit in the back five rows of the center section to allow our children to sit in the front. A practice of our Parish is that we are very quiet once we enter the inside doors of church to maintain a prayerful atmosphere.

Una de las muchas maneras en que crecemos en la fe como comunidad escolar es asistiendo a Misa para toda la escuela todos los martes. La misa es la oración más importante de la Iglesia Católica. Los estudiantes de 1º a 5º grado se prepararon esta semana para la Misa visitando la Iglesia, practicando respuestas y movimientos, y aprendiendo sobre la creencia católica en la Presencia Real de Cristo en la Eucaristía. IMMUNIZATIONS Needed-New Students and 7th Graders

Please remember to send in a current copy of your child's immunizations to the school. This applies to your child if they are new to OLG this year or in 7th grade. The 7th grade students need to have the tdap and meningococcal vaccines for entry into 7th grade. These are requirements for the first day of school in the state of Ohio. We have given families a 2 week grace period from the start of school to get these records into school or your child will not be permitted to attend school starting on September 12th.

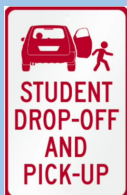

Thank you for helping us in the car lines as we start the year next week! Here are a couple reminders to help us work together for OUR kids:

*Everyone must be patient. The rows are dismissed as all parents have their children in the cars.

*Please pull up as far as you can to the car in front of you. Rows 4 and 5 will be dismissed before the second round of rows 1 and 2.

*Upper Lot: All parents need to get out of their cars to get their child(ren) and then get back in their car as soon as possible.

*Lower Lot: All parents need to stay in their cars. The student will come to you. Also, please wait until the teacher dismisses your row.

*Grades 4-8 Students who are not picked up on time will leave as a walker. Please make sure your student knows where you want them to walk (library, park, etc.)
