Dear OLG Parents,

The recent school shooting in Georgia weighs heavy on all of our minds. We will all continue to pray for the families and the community who lost loved ones in this tragic event. In light of these on-going situations, I am reaching out to you today to share the safety protocols we have in place to ensure our community's safety.

- All school doors remain closed and locked during the school day. Students are not permitted to open any exterior door to anyone. They are reminded of this regularly and are instructed to get their teacher even if they know the person.
- All visitors are required to have an appointment to enter the school building and report to the main office upon arrival. Adults coming to pick up students are instructed to wait outside for the student to exit the building.
- Our Emergency Operations Plan is reviewed and approved by Ohio Homeland Security every year. It is on file with the state, and all faculty and staff are given copies to review annually.
- When the Church is open during the day, all doors leading to it are closed and locked.
- Cameras are located in both the interior and exterior of the building. The office and parish staff have access to the monitoring system at all times.
- Drills for several different emergencies are conducted at different times throughout the year (lockdown, fire, tornado, etc.)

As you can see, we take the safety of our community very seriously. The physical, mental, and spiritual health of our students and faculty is of the utmost importance to us. We are grateful to have the parish community at St. Ann supporting our students spiritually at Tuesday Mass and our mental health supported by our dedicated Beech Acres and OLG staff.

IMMUNIZATIONS Needed-New Students and 7th Graders

Please remember to send in a current copy of your child's immunizations to the school. This applies to your child if they are new to OLG this year or in 7th grade. The 7th grade students need to have the tdap and meningococcal vaccines for entry into 7th grade. These are requirements for the first day of school in the state of Ohio. We have given families a 2 week grace period from the start of school to get these records into school or your child will not be permitted to attend school starting on September 12th.
