Holy Week Comes Alive

As I write this, we are in the middle of Holy Week, the holiest week of the Church year. Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday which celebrates Jesus ride into Jerusalem. Even though Jesus was welcomed with celebration, not long after he is tortured and sentenced to death on a cross after a betrayal from one of His friends.

Jesus death on a cross is commemorated on the day known as Good Friday. 3 short days later, and at the end of Holy Week, we celebrate Easter. Easter is the day when Jesus rose from the grave, overcoming death and providing a means for which everyone can have a relationship with God.

One of the greatest devotions of Holy Week is the Stations of the Cross. The Stations of the Cross are a 14-step Catholic devotion that commemorates Jesus Christ's last day on Earth as a man. The 14 devotions, or stations, focus on specific events of His last day, beginning with His trial and sentencing.



The stations are commonly used as a mini pilgrimage as the individual moves from station to station. At each station, the individual recalls and meditates on the station. Specific prayers are recited, then the individual moves to the next station until all 14 are complete.



The Stations of the Cross are commonly found in churches as a series of 14 small icons or images. They can also appear in church yards arranged along paths. The stations are most commonly prayed during Lent on Wednesdays and Fridays, and especially on Good Friday, the day of the year upon which the events actually occurred.





Each year here at OLGCS our Junior High presents the Living Stations of the Cross where students enact and story-tell each of the 14 stops of Jesus on the Way of the Cross. I walked the stations with the First Graders this year and found that the students were really listening as they told the story and prayed with them.

I have included some photos of this year's stations. Teaching our faith is most effective when the stories we so often hear come alive in a program such as this. *Great job, Junior High!*Mark Friedman, CRE



- Can be paper medium or computer-generated image


