Mary is our Mother

When growing up, I remember many a time when I wanted to do something that I had to ask my parents' permission for. Nine out of ten of those times, I would go to my mother to ask Dad for permission. Sure, I could have gone straight to Dad, but it seemed like a better idea to get someone like Mom on my side before going to the big guy. With mom behind me approving my request, it felt like there was less of a chance Dad would refuse. As I think back about this – I realize now that it directly related to my currently relationship with the Blessed Mother. This is how Mary plays into my life. I go to my spiritual mother Mary, first, and then we go to God together.

I lost my own mother ten years ago to Alzheimer's, although it was like we lost her during the last two years of her life that she suffered with that heartbreaking disease. It was August, only fifteen days after we buried Mom that I was asked to sing at a Mass at the Cathedral in Downtown Cincinnati on the feast of the Assumption of Mary – the celebration of Mary being taken up into heaven body and soul. I remember feeling very sad during that Mass and really missing Mom. I can recall praying to Mary during the quiet parts of the Mass and saying how much I missed my Mother and asked Mary to pray for her and for me. When Mass was over I was walking to the parking garage, when I passed a phone booth (remember this was ten years ago!) where an old woman with her back to me was looking in the coin return for money that may have dropped from a caller's pocket.

I guess the lady saw me out of the corner of her eye and said "son, could you spare a couple dollars?" My first reaction was my typical negative reaction to all panhandlers – but she was elderly and I did just come from church. So I reached in my pocket and pulled out a ten dollar bill. *Too much* was my first thought, but then the old woman turned around - and what I saw staring kindly up at me was my own Mother's face! Of course not exactly her, but she bore a striking resemblance to the Mom I knew before dementia and Alzheimer's had really aged her. She had that smile I remember so well and memories flooded back into my head. I was stunned and I began tearing up. I was actually shaking. "What's the matter, son?" She said with love - and it was all I could do to smile and hand her the money. "It's way too much" she said, "but thank you." *And she walked away*.

Mary is our mother, and she cares for us. She plays a major role now in my life and I know that I can always go to her as I did with my own Mother when things get hard and stressful. By the way, my Mom's name was Ann – which was also the name of Mary's mother. I will always be grateful to her for hearing my prayer at Mass that day ten years ago – *and for the gift Mary gave me on her feast day*.


We will then go back to the classrooms for final summer preparations. At 12:15, you are invited to sign your child(ren) out from their homerooms for our family picnic out on the field. **You are welcome to take your child(ren) home after lunch**. (If it rains, the picnic will be held inside.)

The cafeteria will have a brown bag style lunch and milk available for students to purchase or students can pack their own lunch from home. Adults/family members can bring their own lunches to enjoy with the students.

We understand not all parents are able to attend our picnic, so teachers will have lunch with students whose parents are unable to attend. They will supervise them until dismissal at 2:50 p.m. Buses will be running at their normal times for those students.

Meal Accounts as the School Year Wraps Up

- Meal Money Will Carry Over- Any money on your child's lunch account at the end of the year will automatically carry over to next school year.
- Graduating 8th Graders Accounts- Money left in 8th grade accounts will be automatically transferred to a younger sibling in the same household. If there is no sibling, the cafeteria staff will be contacting 8th grade parents as graduation approaches to make arrangements for a refund or to donate remaining funds to a younger student.
- Students Who Are Not Returning Next Year- Please contact the school cafeteria before the last week of school to arrange for a refund of any remaining money. Refunds will be made during the last week of school.
- K-12 Payment System Closes for Summer- During the summer, K-12 Payment Accounts cannot be viewed or money added to accounts until the next school year approaches. The K-12 Payment System utilizes the summer break to update their website and features.
