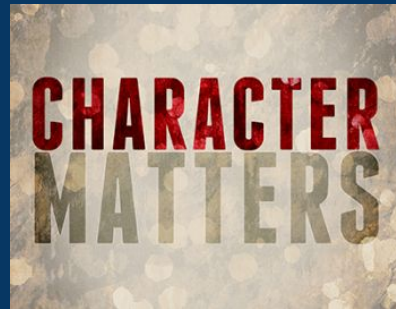

Boys Volleyball

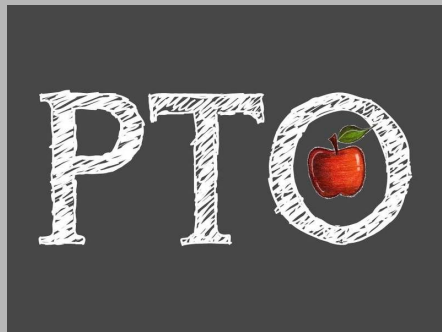
