Cafeteria Q&A:

What if my child who is on free or reduced lunch only wants a milk or a single item?

We are only reimbursed by the USDA for complete meals. If your child only wants a milk or a single menu item then those items are available for cash purchase on an individual basis; for example, milk costs 50 cents. In order to be free, your child must take a complete meal consisting of three different items (one being a fruit or vegetable).



Notes from the Nurse

Fall is now officially upon us. It won't be long before the cold and flu season is upon us. I would like to encourage your family to get flu shots. Let's have a healthy school year.

I will be starting vision and hearing screening with the kindergarten classes. I will then progress on to 3rd, 5th, and 7th grades. If you have a concern about either your child's hearing or vision, please let me know and I will screen them right away and get back to you.

There are just a couple of reminders today:

- All medicine, including over-the-counter medicine, requires a written doctor's order. The medication form can be printed out by going to the school's website. It is listed under resources in the right hand column. This includes everything except non-medicated cough drops. Non-medicated cough drops, such as Luden's may be sent to school with a parent note. Everything else requires a written doctor's order.
- Children with a fever (that is a temperature greater than 100 degrees) should not return to school until they are fever free for 24 hours without taking anything for it. If your child is started on an antibiotic,

- they need to stay home until they have been on the antibiotic for at least 24 hours. Please keep your child home if they are vomiting, have diarrhea, or pinkeye.
- Please be sure to keep the clinic and office notified of any phone number changes throughout the year so we may notify you if your child is injured or becomes ill.
